Stories can stimulate imagination and play

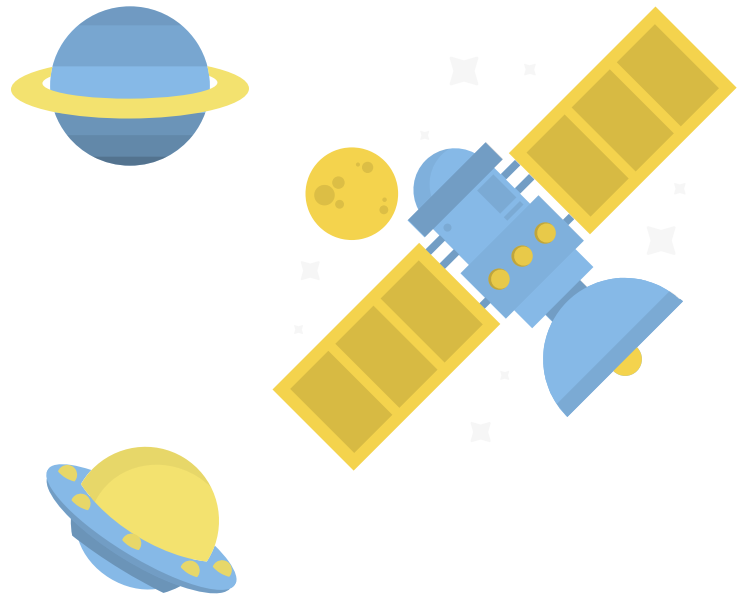


A toddler's vocabulary at the age of 2 is a predictor of success later in life. A child living in poverty is exposed to as many as 30 million fewer words than his or her peers



Books and stories fill a child's mind with knowledge

In the lowest income neighborhoods in America, there is 1 book for every 300 children. In the middle class, there are 13 books for each child.



Reading provides parents with more opportunities to bond with their children



Children not reading by 3rd grade are four times more likely to drop out of high school
